¹ The law of freedom includes the principle of tolerance: to allow all people to hold their own views in peace from the criticism of others. Everybody has an absolute right to his own opinion. We have full freedom to hold the most erroneous views on everything. They will be corrected eventually during thousands of incarnations with more or less painful experiences.

² The fact that the individual has a right to his own view of life does not at all mean that his (page25) view is objectively correct, that it accords with reality. Since 99 per cent of most people's opinions are erroneous, it should be realized that nobody has a right to say that his view is the only correct one. Practically everybody is wrong, although of course not to the same degree. The specialist knows immensely more within his sphere than does the layman. But he is not omniscient. The matter can be drastically expressed thus: the sooner man realizes that he is an idiot, the wiser he is.
